Your prompt attention to this request will avoid conclusion of misprision of felony on your part and avert my request to the Attorney General for preliminary investigation pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 591 as to whether you may have violated Federal criminal law by failing to act.

Your failure to respond in the affirmative to this request within 10 days of your/office receipt of this letter will be presumed a denial of said request and will trigger my further pursuit of administrative remedies as set forth herein.
