RE: Demand for Authority: Case number: 3-05-CR-119.

Dear: Mr. Ely

On September 21, 2005, your agents (Vicky Burge, Ralph Rocco and Robert Hernandez) purporting to act on your orders or under your authority, arrested my Daughter, **Jolene: Patterson,** a living soul, within the ULTA Salon, 12864 South Freeway, in the city of Burleson, County of Tarrant, State of Texas, on private property and without an Arrest Warrant in their possession.

I have recently discovered that A. Joe Fish, Chief Judge, United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas (U.S.D.C. NDT) and Richard B. Roper, United States Attorney for the Northern District of Texas, have publicly admitted that "a summons or arrest warrant issuing from the U.S.D.C NDT **MAY NOT** be executed within the exterior boundaries of Texas State on property not subject to the jurisdiction of the United States."(1)

I understand that Article 1 Section 8 Clause 17 of the Constitution For The United States limits authority of Congress and the Federal government — specifically enforcement of Federal criminal law — on this continent to the District of Columbia and PLACES PURCHASED (2) within a union State by the Federal government. I do not believe the judicial district known, as "Northern District of Texas" is a PLACE PURCHASED by the federal government. I know for a fact that the above referenced place of arrest is NOT A PLACE PURCHASED by the Federal government.

Presuming what Chief Judge Fish and U.S. Attorney Roper have admitted is correct, and I have no reason to doubt them, you may have executed the arrest without lawful authority. (3) If so, you may have violated the Constitutions of the United States and Texas and committed Federal and State crimes including perjury for violation of your Oath Of Office.

As One of the People, I demand that you produce the Constitutional, statutory or any other authority upon which you relied to effect the arrest of **Jolene: Patterson, a living soul**, on private property. Failure on your part to produce documented evidence of Lawful authority, within ten (10) days of your acceptance of this letter, will establish by acquiescence, your admission, you and your agents acted without lawful authority and I will have a nihil dicit judgment that you and your agents are acting under color of law and color of authority.

If you do not establish that you and your agents acted within lawful Constitutional authority, I will initiate requests to the Director of the United States Marshal Service and the Attorney General of the United States requesting a Criminal Investigation (4) of your activities in Texas.

Further, if you fail to produce lawful authority, please consider this letter as documentation holding you personally responsible to proceed to effect the immediate and unconditional release of the named person arrested, **Jolene: Patterson**, a living soul, in order to avoid conclusion of misprision of felony.
